Reporting the latest available annual data from the U.S. Census and Bills of Lading with cumulative trade values over the preceding year and comparisons with previous years. Data provided to end of 2018, the latest full year of data.

ABOUT THIS REPORT:

Designed as a reference on U.S. import trade for port authorities, carriers, logistics providers, importers and shippers, this report ranks the top 20 U.S. maritime ports by import volumes, measured in Twenty-foot Equivalent Units (TEU), the standard measure of containerized cargo, for 2018.

ABOUT THE DATA

The data source for this report is Descartes Datamyne, provider of the world's largest searchable trade database covering the global commerce of 230 markets across 5 continents.

The U.S. ports data in this report has been gathered by Descartes Datamyne from bills of lading (BoLs) that document inbound ocean shipments and are filed with U.S. Customs Automated Commercial Environment (ACE). TEU volumes reported are derived from bills of lading, as released by U.S. Customs, excluding empty containers and shipments with freight remaining on board (FROB). The value of imports is as reported by U.S. Census.

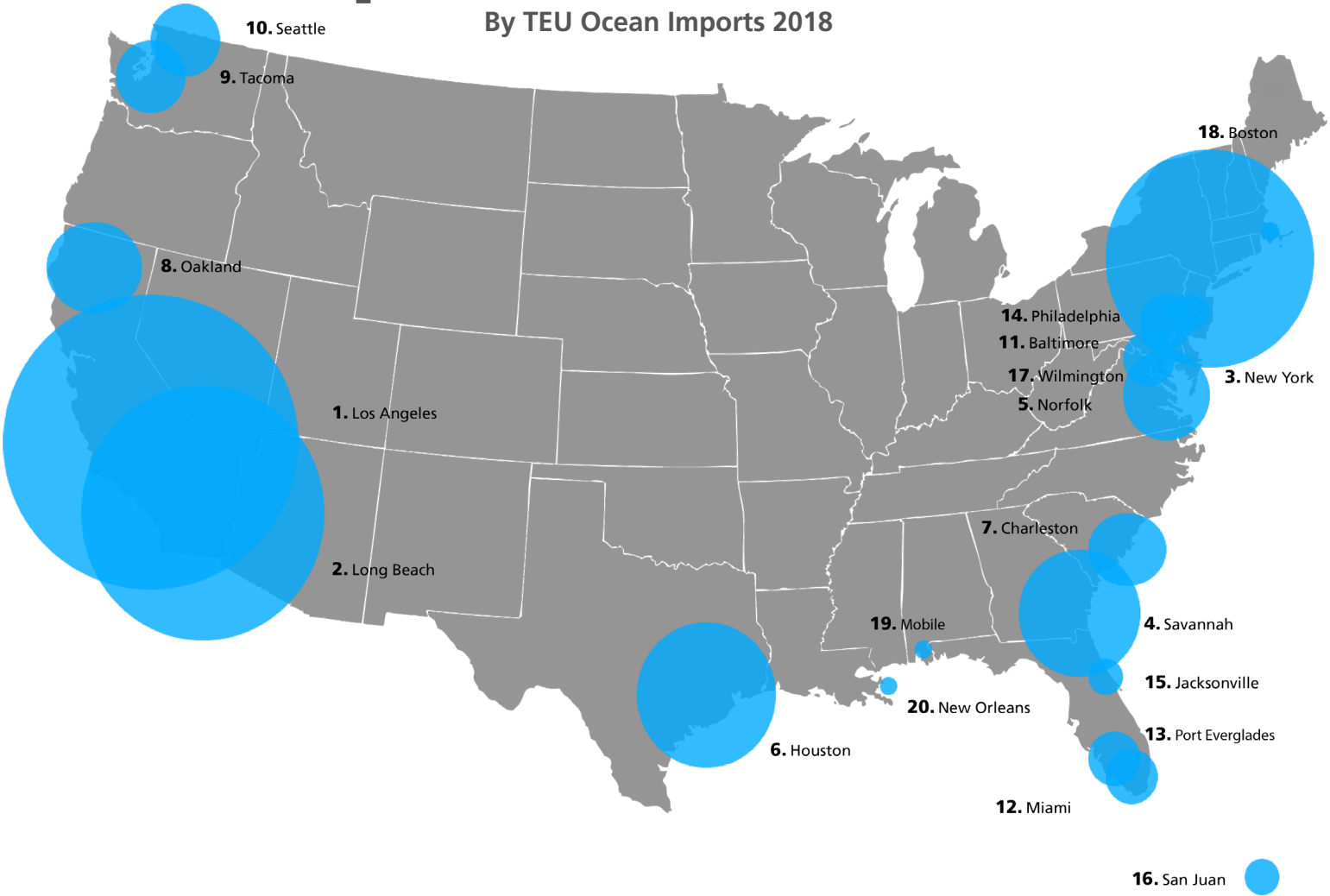
Countries of origin reported are the countries from which shipments departed bound for the United States. Leading importers are the companies identified as consignees on bills and taking delivery on the highest volumes of imports as measured in TEUs. Master carriers are the top shipping lines ranked by TEUs as reported on the bills of lading. Number of shipments reported is the number of bills of lading.

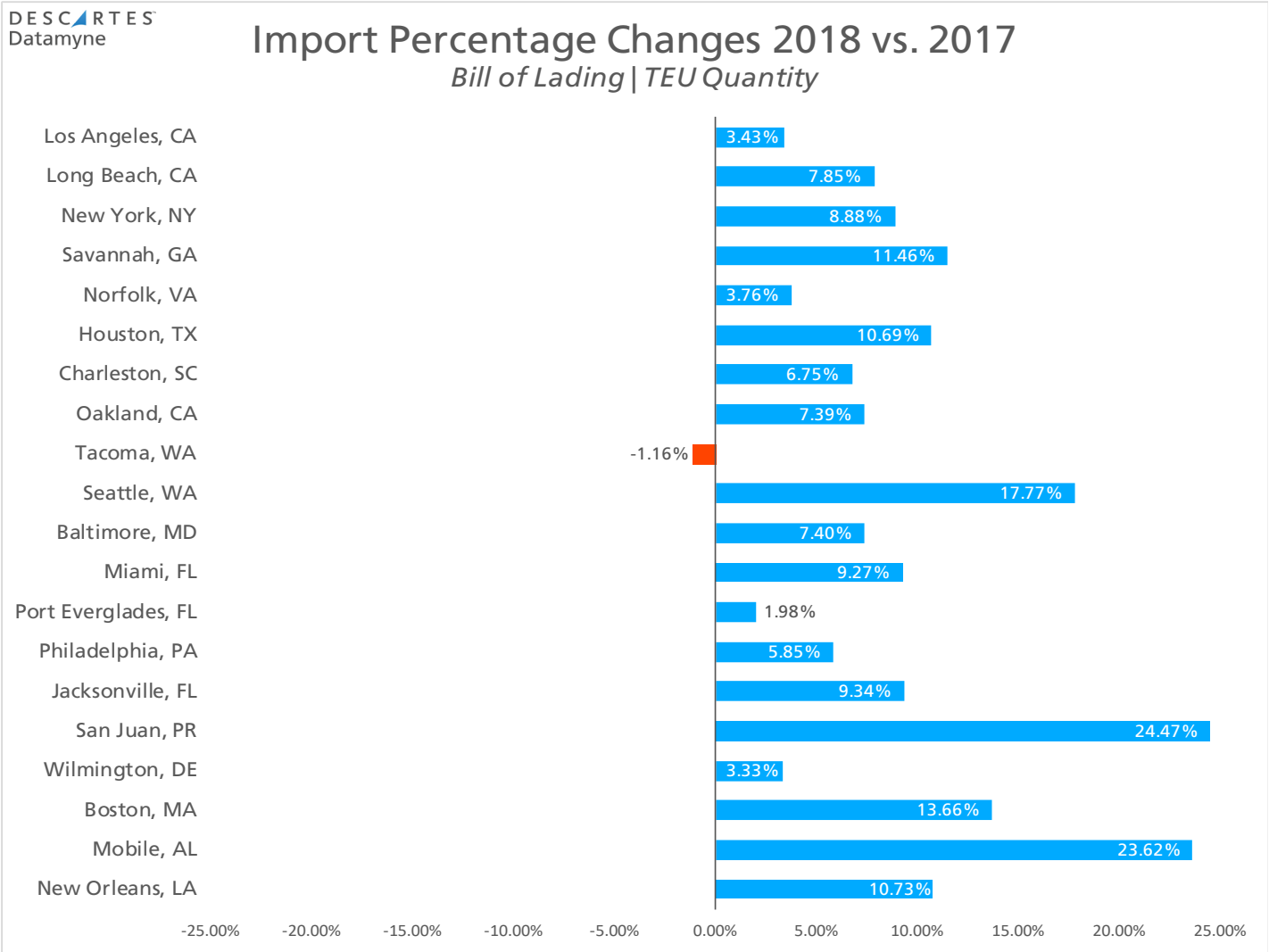

Top 20 U.S. Ports Year-Over-Year

What You Need to Know:



Overall, U.S. import volume increased 7.4 percent in 2018 compared to 2017, with more than 24 million twenty-foot equivalent units imported across maritime ports.

In 2015, the [Port of Miami](#) completed an expansion of its Biscayne Bay and the Port of Miami Tunnel Project. The first benefits of this project are beginning to be seen, with import volumes increasing 9.3 percent.

Continuing a trend, the [Port of Tacoma](#) has posted a slight decline in 2018 import volume compared to 2017, falling a further 1.6 percent after a 15.9 percent drop in 2017. Tacoma is the only port in the top 20 to see a decline in 2018 and, similar to 2017, this drop is offset by a 17.8 percent increase in volume by its sister port in the Northwest Seaport Alliance, the [Port of Seattle](#).

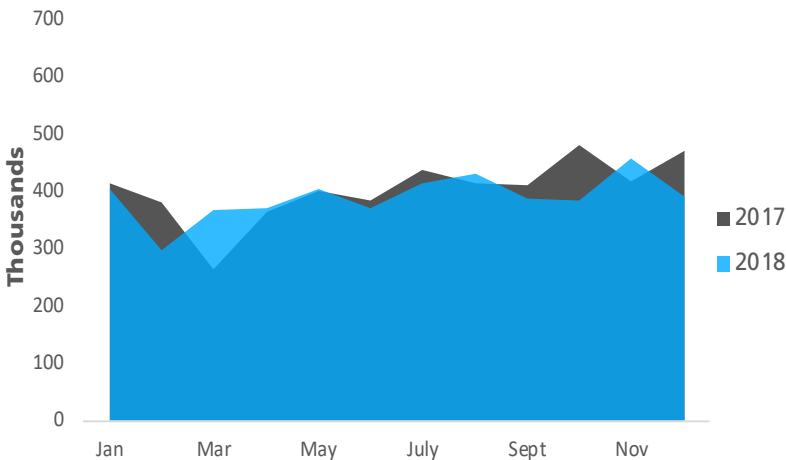
For the second year in a row, the [Port of Mobile](#) has maintained its position among the top U.S. ports, this year climbing to 19th with import volumes rising a futher 23.62 percent in 2018 after an already impressive 15.5 percent increase in 2017. The port is well underway into Phase 3 of its five-part expansion project. The multi-billion-dollar long-term plan is designed to increase the port’s throughput volume to 1.5 million TEUs. The \$49.5 million, Phase 3, expansion is expected to be completed by 2020.

The [Port of Long Beach](#), the second most active port in the country, maintained a record pace set in the first quarter of 2018, closing out the year with a 7.9 percent increase in volume over an already record-setting 2017.

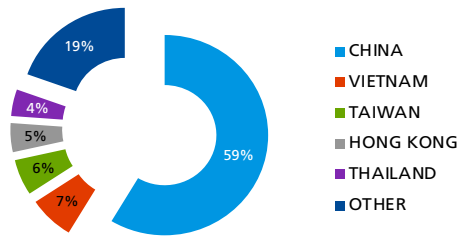

Despite a sluggish first quarter that saw a 5.7 percent drop in overall shipments compared to 2018, Los Angeles increased TEU imports from 2017 to 2018 by 3.43 percent. While this is a noticeable slow from the port's peak 2016 increase of 9.3 percent, it is a moderate improvement over 2017's growth of 3.14 percent. Total TEUs amounted to 4.84 million in 2018 compared to 4.67 million in 2017.

The top products by four digit Harmonized System (HS) codes imported into Los Angeles, by TEU volume, were furniture [HS 9403 and 9401] and the parts & accessories for motor vehicles [HS 8708].

The top imports by total FOB value remain the same as 2017, with motor vehicles [HS 8703] amounting to \$11.6B in total import value and automatic data processing machines [HS 8471] with \$9.8B.

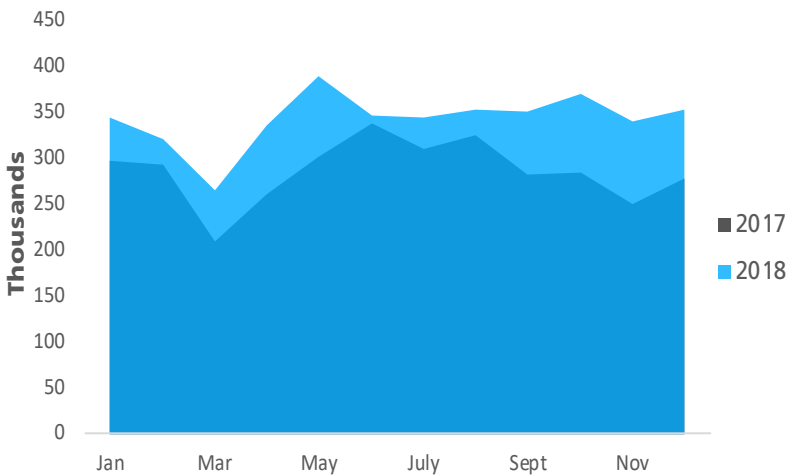
Countries of Origin (TEUs)



2. LONG BEACH, CA

Import TEUs 2017 vs. 2018



The Port of Long Beach realized an impressive increase in TEU imports in 2018. The second most active port in the country saw total imports rise 7.9 percent from 3.8 million to 4.1 million. More dramatically, Long Beach increased in the total value of imported goods by 13.3 percent, totaling almost \$75 billion in 2018.

Petroleum oil [HS 2709] remains the top product imported to Long Beach, with a total FOB value reaching \$6.6B, a 34.2 percent increase over 2017. Similar to Los Angeles, automatic data processing machines [HS 8471] were the second-highest value product with \$3.2B in total import value.

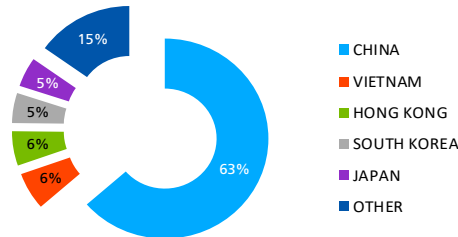

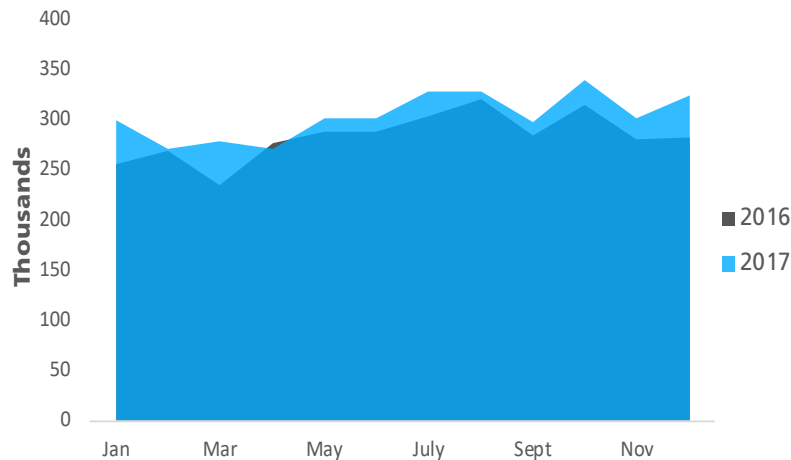

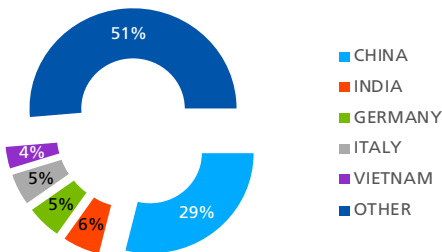

The Ports of New York, NY and Newark, NJ increased in TEU imports from 2017 to 2018 by 8.9 percent. The total value of goods imported increased by 13.9 percent and totaled \$188.2B in 2018.

New York and Newark's top imported products by value were passenger motor vehicles [HS 8703] and petroleum oil [HS 2710]. Passenger vehicles imports totaled \$12.68 billion and petroleum oil totals \$10.1 billion. Medicaments fell to third place in 2018 despite a significant increase over 2017 of 52.16 percent to a total value of \$8.6 billion.

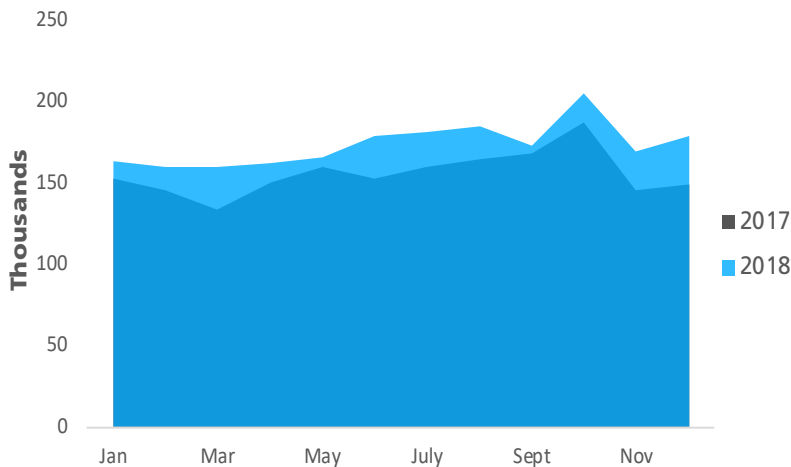

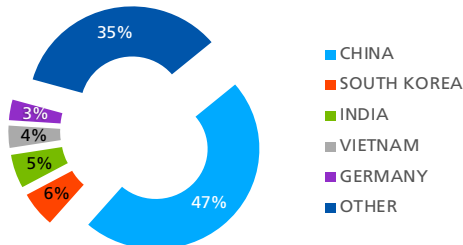

The Port of Savannah increased in TEU imports from 2017 by 11.5 percent, totaling 2.1 million in 2018. The port also brought in \$74.4 billion worth of goods in 2018, a 15.7 percent increase in value from the previous year.

Savannah's leading products in 2018 were, by import value, parts and accessories for special purpose motor vehicles (HS 8708) and food preparations (HS 1616).

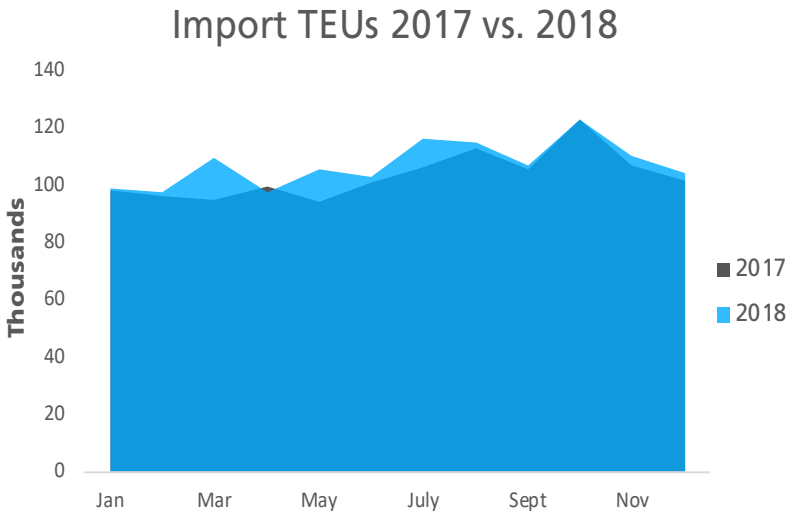
Top imports by TEU volume for the fourth busiest port in the country were similar to that of top-ranked Los Angeles. Furniture [HS 9403 & 9401] and motor vehicle parts and accessories [HS 8708] accounted for the top two spots.

5. NORFOLK, VA

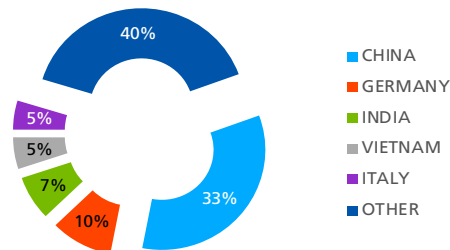

The Port of Norfolk was ranked fifth in TEU imports to the United States again in 2018, maintaining its position for the third year in a row. Norfolk imported nearly 1.3 million TEUs in 2018, 3.8 percent more than 2017; however, this was rather sluggish compared to the other top ports in the country. Norfolk's total FOB value reached \$49.2 billion worth of goods in 2018, 6.7 percent higher than 2017.

Medicaments [HS 3004] lead products, in terms of value, imported to the Port of Norfolk, reaching a total value of \$3.1 billion. This amounts to a vast increase in value of 175.6 percent compared to 2017. This is a substantial recovery for the value of imported medicine after a 22.8 percent decline in 2017.

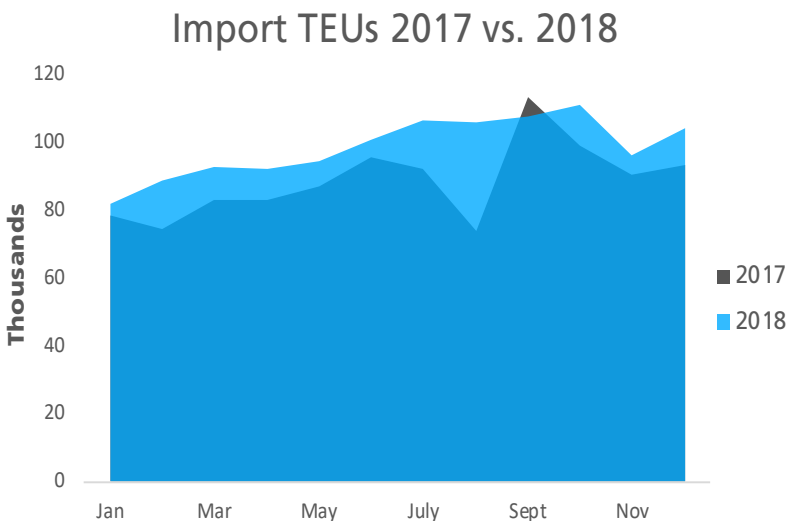

6. HOUSTON, TX

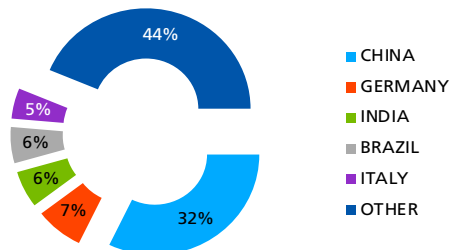

The Port of Houston maintained its two position jump from 2017 to the sixth busiest U.S. port. The port saw imports increase in 2018 by 10.7 percent to a total 1.2 million TEUs. The total value of goods imported to Houston also increased by 16.3 percent from 2017, with a total value of nearly \$69.6 billion.

Similar to past few years, the top imported products imported into the Port of Houston in 2018 were both oils. Petroleum oils, crude [HS 2709] totaled nearly \$11.1 billion in 2018, an increase of 18.1 percent from the previous year. Petroleum oils, other than crude [HS 2710] increased by an even more impressive 103 percent to a total value of almost \$7 billion.

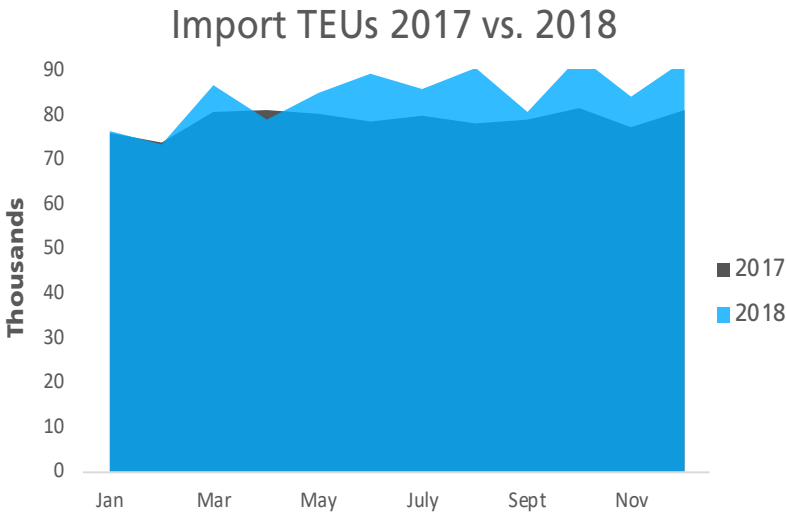

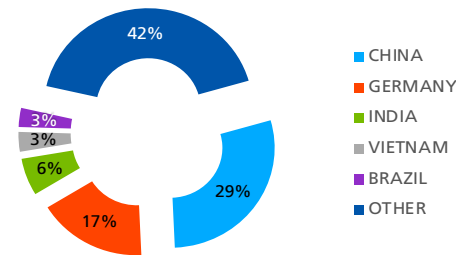

The Port of Charleston had over a million TEUs imported in 2018, a 6.8 percent increase from 2017. The total value of imports in 2017 amounted to over \$50 million, which was a 6.7 percent increase from 2016.

Parts and accessories for special purpose motor vehicles [HS 8708] and aircraft parts (HS 8803) were the top products imported into the Port of Charleston by value. Motor vehicle parts and accessories totaled \$3.52 billion and parts for aircraft reached a value of \$2.55 billion in 2018.

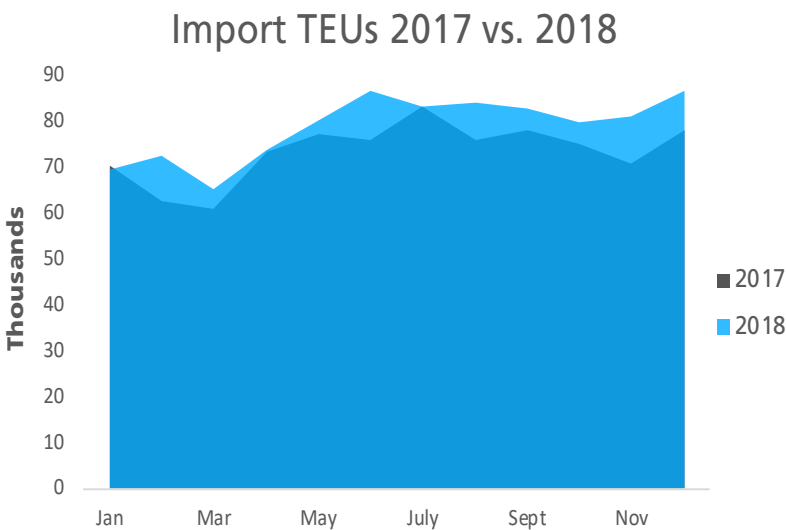
Parts and accessories for motor vehicles was also the top import by TEU, with 39.9 thousand twenty-foot equivalent units imported in 2018. The other top import by TEU was rubber tires [HS 4011] with just over 20 thousand.

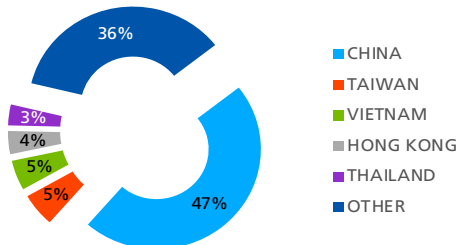

The Port of Oakland maintained its position in the top twenty in 2018, with an increase of 7.39 percent in total TEU imports over 2017. Oakland's total value of imports also increase to \$29.94 billion, a 4.5 percent expansion over 2017's \$28.62 billion.

The top products by value imported through Oakland's port, were motor vehicles [HS 8703] and automatic data processing machines [HS 8471]. Parts and accessories for data processing machines maintained its import value growth from 2017 and had a total value of over \$1.1 billion, a 15.8 percent increase over 2017 and over 108 percent compared to 2016.

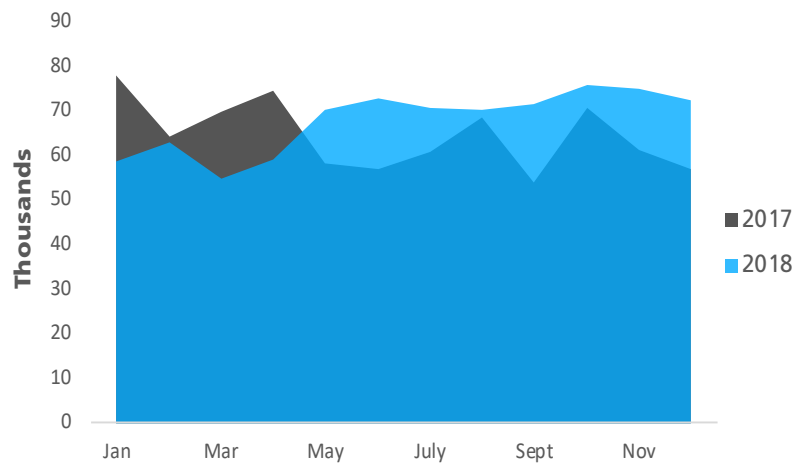

9. TACOMA, WA

Import TEUs 2017 vs. 2018



The Port of Tacoma failed to maintain its position compared to 2017, only handling 812 thousand import TEUs, a 1.2 percent decline from 2017. This places Tacoma as the only port in the top twenty with a decline in imports compared to the previous year. Tacoma’s total import value was over \$40.1 billion in goods for 2018, also dropping a percentile from 2017.

The highest-valued products imported into the Port of Tacoma in 2016 were passenger motor vehicles [HS 8703] and parts and accessories for special purpose vehicles [8708].

The highest number of imports by volume were furniture [HS 9403] with 58 thousand TEUs and parts and accessories for motor vehicles with just over 40 thousand.

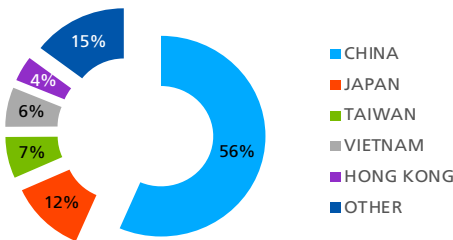

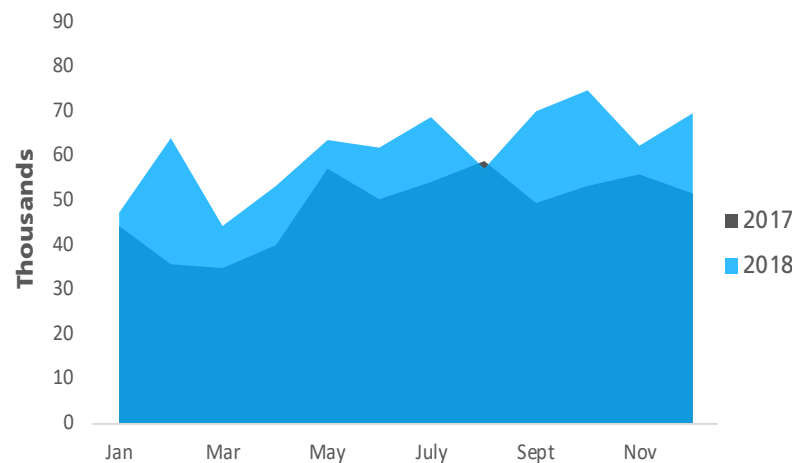

10. SEATTLE, WA

Import TEUs 2017 vs. 2018



The Port of Seattle’s TEU imports totaled over 735 thousand, a significant 17.77 percent increase over 2017 and continuing a trend of growth to the possible detriment of its sister port, the Port of Tacoma. The total value of goods imported into Seattle increased 17.3 percent and totaled \$21.1 billion in 2018.

The leading HS code products, in terms of value, imported through the Port of Seattle were airplane and helicopter parts [HS 8803] and furniture [HS 9403]. Imports of airplane and helicopter parts dropped more than \$50 million from it’s 2017 peak and totaled less than \$633 million. Furniture imports were valued at over \$660 million. Imports of electric storage batteries [HS 8507], 2017’s second-ranked import by value, declined dramatically in 2018, falling over 80 percent compared to 2017.

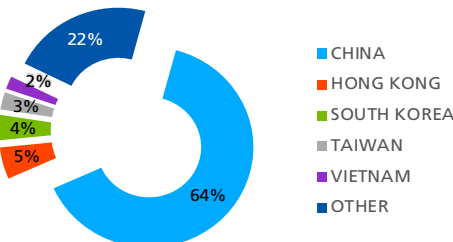

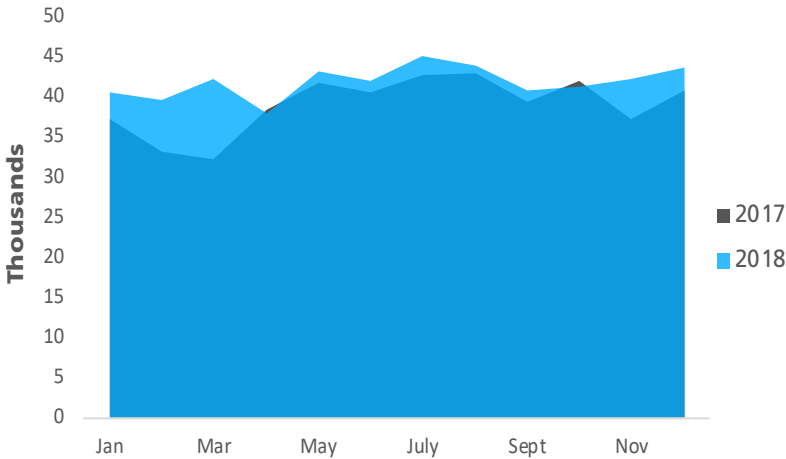

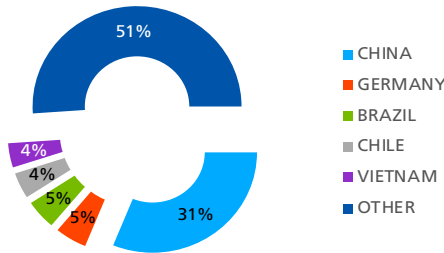

The Port of Baltimore imported over 500 thousand TEUs in 2018. The port is up from 2017 import volume by 7.4 percent. The total value of imports was also up in 2018 by 12.4 percent and totaled \$42.9 billion.

Passenger motor vehicles [HS 8703] are Baltimore's highest value product import by far. In 2018, this value grew by another 10.1 percent to a total of \$14.4 billion. The second highest product by value, with \$1.5 billion worth of imports in 2018, was unwrought aluminum [HS 7601].

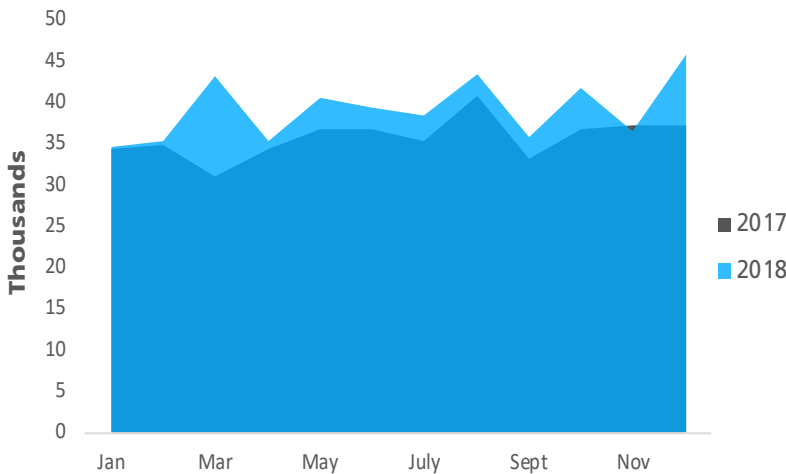

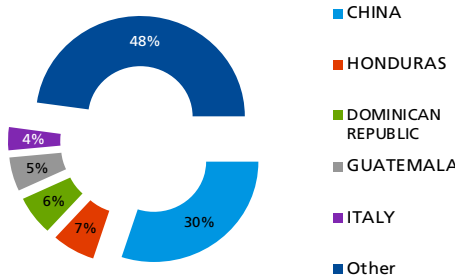
Import TEUs 2017 vs. 2018



After remaining steady throughout 2017, the Port of Miami realized a 9.27 percent growth in 2018 to a total of above 501 thousand. The total value of goods handled at Miami was slightly over \$16 billion, which was a 9.76 percent gain over its import value in 2017.

The top imported products to the Port of Miami were sweaters, t-shirts [HS 6110 & 6109] and cigars [HS 2402]. Cigar imports to Miami totaled over \$760 and increased 8.6 percent from 2017. This is the second year that the value of cigar imports to the Port of Miami has grown significantly.

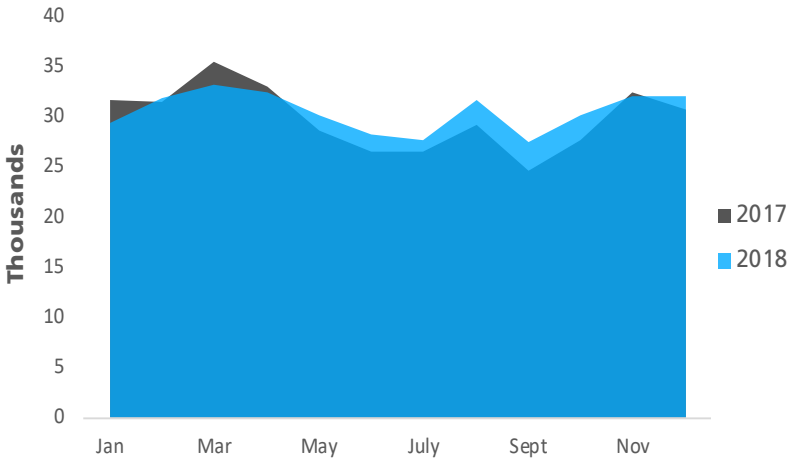

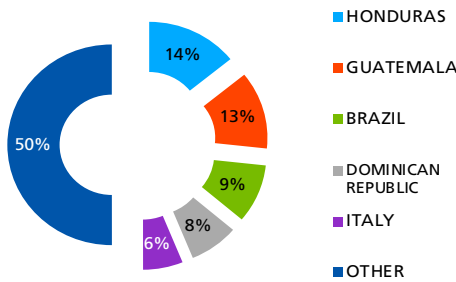
Import TEUs 2017 vs. 2018



With 365,868 TEUs imported to the Port Everglades in 2018, its import volume was almost 2 percent higher than that of 2017. The port’s total value of imports performed better and increased 6.3 percent to over \$11.8 billion in 2018.

The top imported products in 2017 to Port Everglades were petroleum oils [HS 2710] and shirts [HS 6109]. Petroleum oils rebounded from its 2017 drop and had a total value of over \$1.03 billion, climbing 41 percent from 2017. Shirts fell just behind petroleum and had a total value of \$1.02 billion.

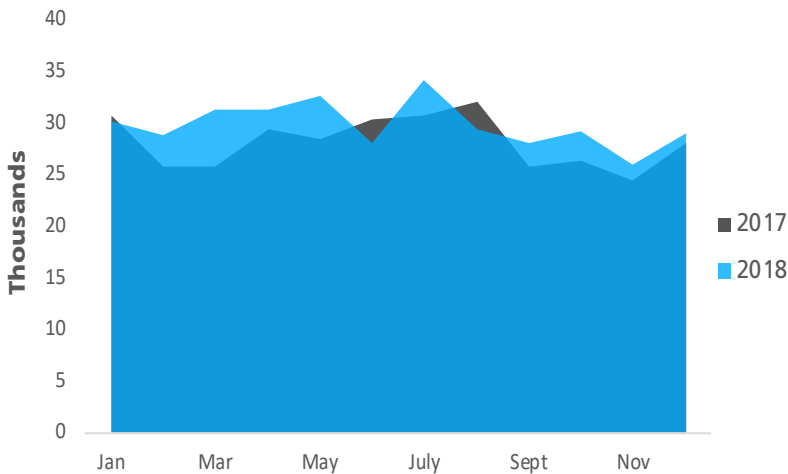

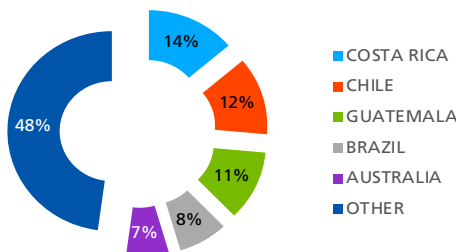
Import TEUs 2017 vs. 2018



The Port of Philadelphia’s total TEU import volume was over 357 thousand in 2018. This was a 5.85 percent increase from its volume in 2017, which itself saw a 22 percent increase compared to 2016. Philadelphia’s total number of shipments increased 8.7 percent to 132,518 and the total value increased 14.25 percent to \$24.8 billion in 2018.

Petroleum Oils [HS 2709] and passenger motor vehicles [HS 8703] were the top products imported to Philadelphia in 2018. Crude petroleum increased 57 percent in import value to a total of \$3.36 billion. This is the second year of significant growth for the imports of petroleum into Philadelphia. Passenger vehicles had a total value in 2018 of \$2.4 billion.

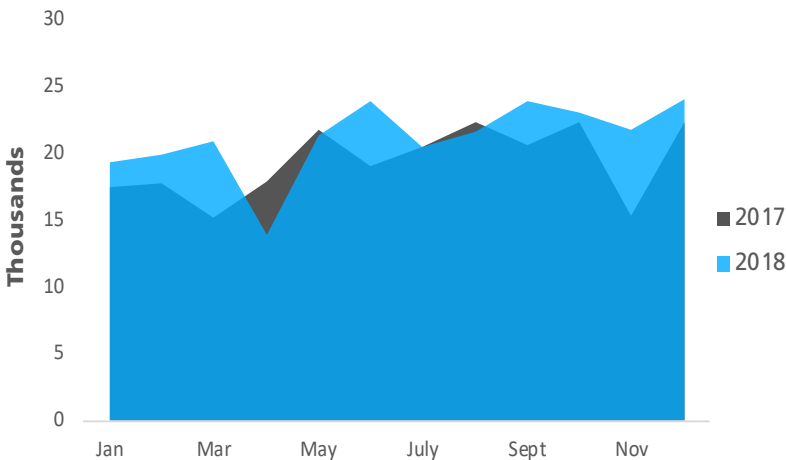

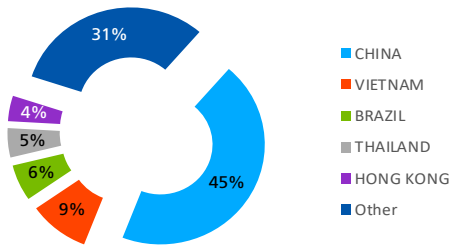
Import TEUs 2017 vs. 2018



The Port of Jacksonville imported over 253 thousand TEUs, an 9.3 percent increase from 2017. Jacksonville’s increase in value, however, was even more impressive; rising 31.51 percent in total value to \$19.2 billion in 2018.

The top products imported through the Port of Jacksonville were passenger motor vehicles [HS 8703.23 and 8703.24]. The total import value for HS 8703.23 was nearly \$7.65 billion in 2018, a 14.4 percent increase from 2016. HS 8703.24 had a total value of \$3.04 billion but decreased in value by 10.9 percent.

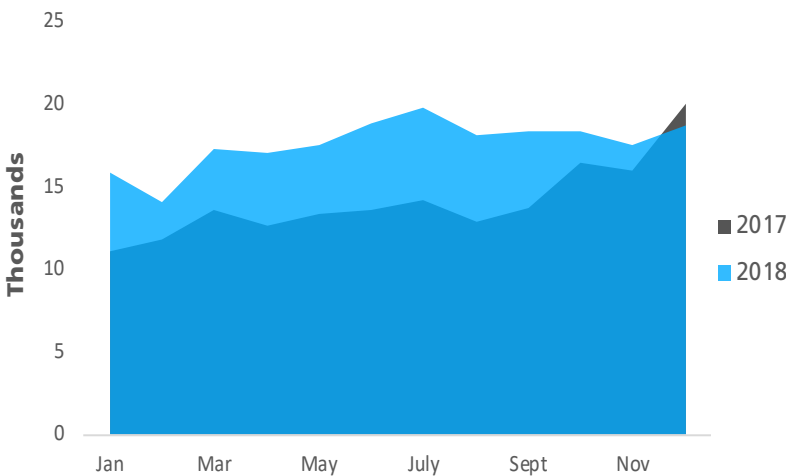

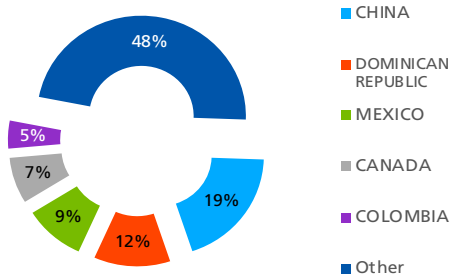
Import TEUs 2017 vs. 2018



The only change in the top 20 U.S. Ports rankings, the Port of San Juan, in the U.S. territory of Puerto Rico, rose one position and imported over 211 thousand TEUs in 2018, which was a 24.5 percent increase from 2017. Total shipments to the port still recovering from Hurricane Maria reached over 94 thousand, a 20.7 percent increase, and the total value of imports was over \$7.7 billion in 2018, a 32.4 percent increase from 2017.

The highest-valued products by HS code imported into San Juan were petroleum oils [HS 2710.19] and light oils [HS 2710.12]. Petroleum oils had a total value of \$731 million in 2018, increasing 29.3 percent from 2017. Light oils valued at \$604.2 million and increased 11.8 percent from 2017.

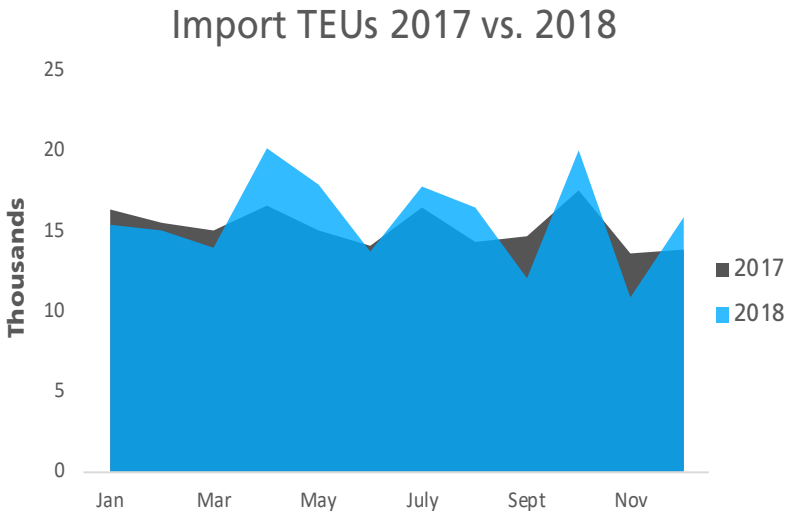

The Port of Wilmington’s total TEU imports reached nearly 189 thousand in 2018, which was an increase of 3.3 percent compared to 2017. The total import value of goods through Wilmington increased significantly however, \$10.9 billion in 2018, 21.8 percent higher than 2017. This is the second year in a row that the total import value of goods into Wilmington has grown by over 20 percent.

The highest-valued products by HS code imported to the Port of Wilmington were petroleum oils [HS 2709] and bananas [HS 0803.90]. Petroleum oils totaled \$7.1 billion with an increase of 39.2 percent. Bananas maintained its 2017 numbers, gaining 0.2 percent and totaling \$518 million in 2018.

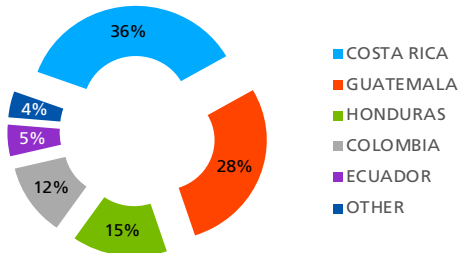

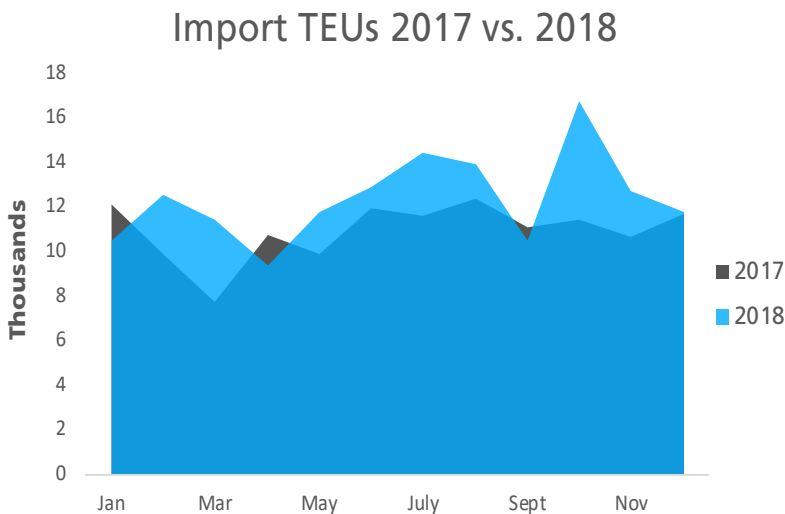

The Port of Boston had TEU imports totaling over 148,000, a 13.66 percent increase from 2017. The total value of goods imported to Boston increased 11.4 percent and totaled \$9.3 billion.

The leading product, measured by total import value, for the Port of Boston in 2018 was light oils [HS 2710.12]. Light oils had a total value of over \$2.28 billion in 2017, increasing from 2017 by 15.5 percent. Passenger motor vehicles [HS 8703.23] were the second-highest imported product but decreased 5.5 percent in total value to \$703 million in 2018.

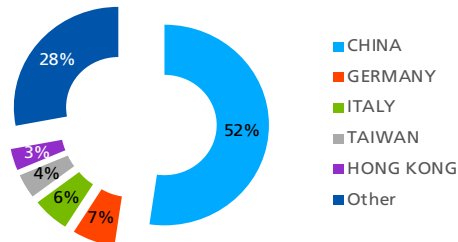

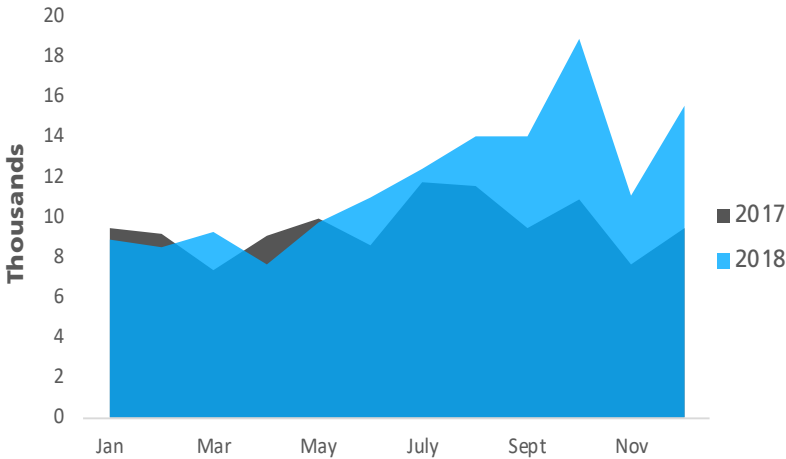

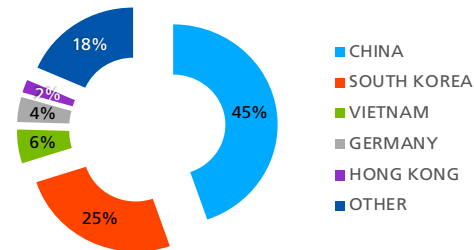

Maintaining its newly top 20 U.S. port placing from 2017, the Port of Mobile had TEU imports totaling over 141,000, a 23.6 percent increase from 2017. Mobile had the highest increase in total value of goods imports, with imports rising 49.5 percent to over \$12.4 billion from \$8.3 billion in 2017.

The top imported products in 2018 to the Port of Mobile were petroleum oils [HS 2710.19] and semi-finished products of iron or steel [HS 7207.12]. Petroleum oils had a total value of over \$2.3 billion and increased 18.8 percent from 2017. Semi-finished iron and steel products had a total value of \$781.5 million and increased 40.4 percent from the previous year.

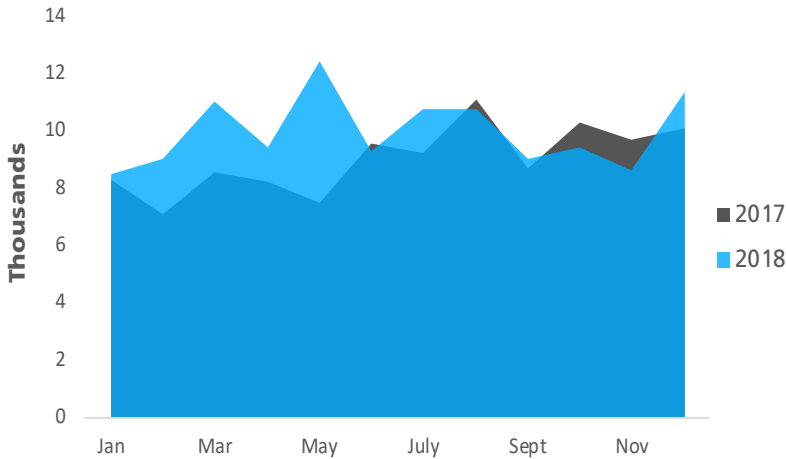

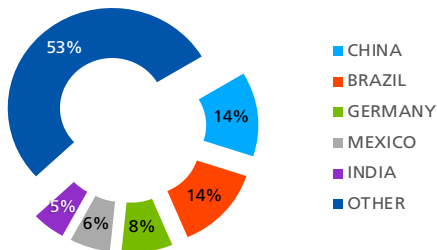
Import TEUs 2017 vs. 2018



The Port of New Orleans increased in TEU imports by 10.7 percent from 2017, recovering from its 2017 decline and importing over 119,000 TEUs in 2018. The Port of New Orleans' total imported value of goods in 2018 was \$69.8 billion, an 8.7 percent increase from 2017.

The top products, in terms of value, for the Port of New Orleans were processors and controllers of electronic integrated circuits [HS 8542.31] and Petroleum Oils [HS 2710.19]. Processors and controllers had a value of \$3.14 billion, a slight decrease of 0.7 percent from 2017. Petroleum oils increased in value by 6.4 percent to a total of \$3.1 billion in 2018.
