
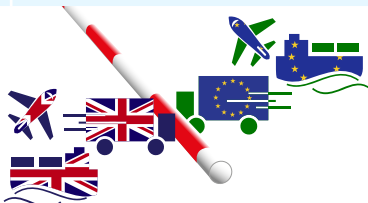


# Brexit Checklist

*Regardless of any UK-EU agreement, the end of the Transition period will bring additional customs formalities on goods moving between the UK and the EU and GB to NI. Are you prepared for Brexit? Read our checklist to make sure you are ready.*



<p>1</p> 	<p>Do you understand how customs declarations on export AND import will affect your supply chains and routes used?</p>	<p>6</p> 	<p>Have you considered submitting your own declarations (Import, Export, Transit, Excise, Safety &amp; Security) in the UK or the EU.</p>
<p>2</p> 	<p>Are you planning to make changes to your supply chain to ship direct to or from the EU or UK where you currently consolidate in one?</p>	<p>7</p> 	<p>Do you need to exchange data with brokers, hauliers, port terminals, customs authorities, government agencies etc. to ensure declarations have been submitted before you move goods?</p>
<p>3</p> 	<p>Have you identified what data would be required for trading on third country terms - tariff codes, landed cost impact etc?</p>	<p>8</p> 	<p>Do you need to invest in a customs warehouse, temporary storage (ETSF) solution or use special procedures to reduce additional costs?</p>
<p>4</p> 	<p>Are you are registering companies and/or obtaining EORs in EU or UK or arranging for Fiscal representation especially if you currently ship on DDP terms.</p>	<p>9</p> 	<p>Are you applying for AEO status approval to facilitate customs warehousing or temporary storage and simplified procedures or waivers, plus potential unknown benefits under any final agreement (if there is one)?</p>
<p>5</p> 	<p>Will the use of Transit facilitate your movements through the UK and the EU ports?</p>
