Am I ready for a Warehouse Management System?

Is my business big enough to need barcode scanning?

Barcode scanning is designed to eliminate picking errors, keep inventories accurate, and increase picking speed. If your business consistently struggles with any of the following issues, then you are big enough to need barcode scanning:

- Must cancel orders because of overselling out-of-stock items

Mobile app-based multi-order picking strategies equip warehouse workers to pick more items in fewer steps. In fact, using these strategies can decrease walking time by up to 90% over single order picking time.

If your warehouse workers struggle to pick all the orders on time every day, your business is big enough to need multi-order picking.

A WMS with multi-order picking will increase overall picking efficiency by 30%.



How much does it cost to implement barcode scanning for NetSuite?

Here is the pricing breakdown for getting started with our solution:

- One-time implementation cost: \$5,000 \$7,500
- Monthly license fee:
 - \$600 per month for 1-2 users
 - \$800 per month for 3-5 users

If you don't already have them, you will also need to purchase mobile barcode scanning devices (Android). A smartphone can work to get started, but you will eventually need rugged devices to withstand frequent use.

Inexpensive option: \$25 - \$300

• Mid-range option: \$400 - \$700

High-end, rugged option: \$1,200

How is the WMS implemented?

Four tips for implementation

1. Develop a project team.
