- Compliance Manager Workflow functionality delivers complete alert adjudication, audit trail reviews, resolution status tracking, and team assignment.
- Includes reporting dashboards for match rate trends, usage metrics, unresolved alert tracking, and batch activity to support internal monitoring and audit readiness.
- Supports independent testing and validation through transparent search logic, artificial intelligence (AI) scoring explanations, and traceable match documentation.
- Enhanced risk data from Dow Jones and Kharon—including Specially Designated Nationals, control/ ownership intelligence, Military End User (MEU) data, and Watchlists to extend Descartes Visual Compliance capabilities beyond regulatory lists including sectoral sanctions detection and reputational risk identification.

The only area traditionally seen as a limitation in list-based screening—sectoral sanctions detection—has been addressed through optional enhanced content subscriptions. With Dow Jones SCO/MEU and Kharon Control datasets embedded, Descartes Visual Compliance customers are equipped to identify sanctions exposure based on ownership or control relationships, filling critical gaps associated with OFAC's 50% rule and EU/UK sectoral sanctions programs.
