Challenge: Manual Processes Were Time Consuming and Error Prone

Operating in over 100 jurisdictions requires access to multiple national tariffs and local guidance (e.g. explanatory notes) for a large number of products, all managed by one team. Potential classification misalignments between regions must be handled individually, country by country, using a risk-based approach.

Regular updates to tariffs must be checked manually across all operational regions, which is a time-consuming process prone to human error. The Markem Imaje Trade Compliance Team faced difficulties in efficiently managing duty rate inquiries for hundreds of HS codes across several countries, with limited bandwidth.

Also, identifying additional requirements and regulations linked to HS codes can be challenging when exporting technological products to multiple destinations.
